



DRESS CODE POLICY

Proper dance attire allows instructors to safely and accurately correct technique while helping dancers develop discipline, confidence, and professionalism in class. All dancers are expected to arrive dressed appropriately for their class style.

General Dress Code Rules

- No jewelry except small stud earrings
 - No tutus or costumes during class
 - No outside shoes allowed in dance studios
 - No smart watches or cell phones inside classrooms
 - Hair must be secured away from the face for all classes
 - Baggy clothing is not permitted unless specifically allowed for Hip Hop

CLASS DRESS CODE REQUIREMENTS

Princess Ballet / Taps & Tutus / Beginning Ballet

Girls

- Pink leotard
- Pink ballet tights
- Pink ballet shoes
- Hair in a neat ballet bun
- Optional: ballet skirts or leg warmers
- Ballet sweaters allowed during colder weather
- No sweatshirts

Boys

- Black ballet shoes
- Black dance pants or black sweats
- Solid white shirt

Beginning Ballet / Level 1 & 2 Ballet

Girls

- Black or pink leotard
- Pink ballet tights
- Pink ballet shoes
- Hair in a neat ballet bun
- Ballet sweater optional
- No sweatshirts

Beginning Ballet / Level 1 & 2 Ballet (cont.)

Boys

- Black ballet shoes
- Black dance pants or black sweats
- Solid black shirt

Level 3, Level 4, Pre-Pointe & Pointe

Girls

- Black leotard
- Pink ballet tights
- Pink ballet shoes
- Hair in a high ballet bun
- Skirts optional
- Ballet sweater optional
- No sweatshirts

Boys

- Black ballet shoes
- Black dance pants
- Solid black shirt

Additional Pointe Requirements

- Pointe dancers must bring all pointe shoes and accessories to every ballet class
- Pre-pointe dancers may wear soft ballet shoes; demi-pointe shoes are not required

Beginning Jazz / Pom

Girls

- Black or pink leotard
- Black dance shorts
- Tan jazz shoes
- Tan tights optional
- Hair secured away from face

Boys

- Tan jazz shoes
- Black dance pants, black athletic shorts, or black sweats
- Solid black shirt
- CCDC shirts permitted

Beginning Tap

Girls

- Black or pink leotard
- Black tap shoes
- Black dance shorts or leggings
- Hair secured away from face
- Optional tights or leg warmers

- No skirts

Boys

- Black tap shoes
- Black dance pants, black athletic shorts, or black sweats
- Solid black or white shirt

Intermediate Tap

Girls

- Fitted dance attire
- Black tap shoes
- Dance shorts or leggings
- Hair secured away from face
- Optional tights or leg warmers
- No skirts

Boys

- Black tap shoes
- Black dance pants, black athletic shorts, or black sweats
- Solid black shirt

Beginning / Intermediate Hip Hop

- Comfortable dance clothing with full range of motion
- Dance-only clean tennis shoes
- Hair secured away from face

Allowed

- Dance tops
- Fitted t-shirts
- Sweatpants
- Dance pants
- Fitted shorts

Not Allowed

- Jeans
- Boxer-style shorts
- Excessively baggy outdoor wear
- Dirty outdoor shoes

Hip Hop shoes may be ordered mid-season.

Advanced Hip Hop

- Comfortable dance attire
- Dance-only sneakers required
- No black sole shoes permitted

Beginning / Intermediate Lyrical

Girls

- Dance-appropriate fitted attire
- Hair half-up or fully secured
- Lyrical shoes required

Boys

- Black dance pants, black athletic shorts, or black sweats
- Solid white or black shirt

Intermediate / Advanced Jazz, Contemporary, Lyrical, Technique & Tricks

- Hair secured away from face
- Fitted dance attire required
- No baggy clothing
- Proper style-specific dance shoes required

Dance Conditioning

- Fitted athletic or dance attire
- No baggy clothing
- Proper dance shoes required when applicable
